Handling Hazmat Products in WFS

Hazmat Classification

Some products require special handling and classification as hazardous materials for WFS. Understanding these requirements prevents shipment rejections and compliance issues.

- Products containing lithium batteries require hazmat classification
- Aerosols, flammable liquids, and compressed gases are regulated
- Cleaning products with certain chemicals may be classified as hazmat
- Safety Data Sheets (SDS) may be required for certain products
- Improperly classified hazmat products can result in fines and account issues

Compliance Steps

Follow these steps to ensure hazmat compliance for WFS.

- Review your product catalog for potential hazmat items
- Obtain Safety Data Sheets (SDS) from your manufacturers
- Submit hazmat documentation through Seller Center as required
- Follow WFS-specific packaging requirements for hazmat items
- Stay updated on hazmat regulation changes that may affect your products
